

GOLF CENTRAL HIGHLANDS

PERPETUAL TROPHY GUIDELINES

GOLFER OF THE YEAR

Format – Gross Stroke Average

1. To be eligible to win Golf Central Highlands Golfer of the Year you must be a member of a club in Golf Central Highlands District and hold a Golf Australia handicap.
2. To qualify for the Perpetual Trophy a player must play in at least four of the nine Open Events in Golf Central Highlands, not including the Central Highlands District Open.
3. The four best gross scores will be tallied, then averaged to determine a players' best gross average for the year.
4. The player with the lowest gross average for the year will be presented with the Perpetual Trophy for Most Consistent Golfer of the Year at the Central Highlands District Open.
5. No nomination fee will be required.
6. Golf Central Highlands will then select a district team of four men based on the overall gross average results to attend the Men's Inter-Association Challenge hosted by Golf Queensland in November of each year. Should a player be unavailable to attend the next player in line will be asked.
7. A player deemed Golfer of the Year is still be eligible for Most Consistent Golfer of the Year.

MOST CONSISTENT GOLFER/S OF THE YEAR

Format – Nett Stroke Average

1. To be eligible to win Golf Central Highlands Most Consistent Golfer of the Year you must be a member of a club within Central Highlands District and hold a Golf Australia handicap.
2. To qualify for the Perpetual Trophy a player must play in at least four of the nine Open Events in Golf Central Highlands, not including the Central Highlands District Open.
3. The four best nett scores will be tallied, then averaged to determine a players' best nett average for the year.
4. The player with the lowest nett stroke average for the year will be presented with the Perpetual Trophy for Most Consistent Golfer of the Year at the Central Highlands District Open.
5. No nomination fee is required.
6. A player deemed Most Consistent Golfer of the Year is still be eligible for Golfer of the Year.
7. In conjunction with the winner of this event, the top four ladies and men's players with the lowest nett stroke average for the year will be offered a \$100 voucher to travel to a sister event or clinic in Central Queensland, Central West or North Queensland of their determining. For example, Sandgreen Championships, Rockhampton Open, Mackay Open, Country Week etc.
8. The four best nett scores will be tallied, then averaged to determine a players' best nett average for the year.
9. The four players will be advised at the Central Highlands Open Presentation in October of each year. The player's chosen event is attended the subsequent year.
10. No nomination fee is required.
11. Any players who has already represented the district that year will not be eligible for this program.

DISTRICT CHAMPION CLUB

Format – Team Pennants

1. The Golf Central Highlands Men's & Ladies Champion Club will be decided over the nine Club Open Events in the district.
2. Team points will be allocated at each Open Event to the clubs who meet the eligibility criteria.
3. Each club may nominate up to five different players to represent their club at any particular Open.
4. The Host Open Club is to collect each team's five nominated players prior to tee off and write them on the "Champion Club Nomination Sheet".
5. The best three nett results from the nominated five players will be taken into consideration and tallied.

2 nd	4
3 rd	3
4 th	2
5 th – 9 th	1

6. Should a club fail to provide their team to the host club prior to tee off they will receive no points for that Open.
7. If clubs score the same nett after the best three are added together the fourth then fifth (if required) nett will decide who finishes higher. If scores are still tied the team's best player nett will decide the tie.
8. The Club with the most points will be named the Champion Club at the Central Highlands District Open. Any club/s sharing total points at the end of the season will share the honour.
9. The points table is shown in the table shown right.
10. The winning Club of the ladies competition will be invited to attend a Pennant Final held within Central Queensland District.
